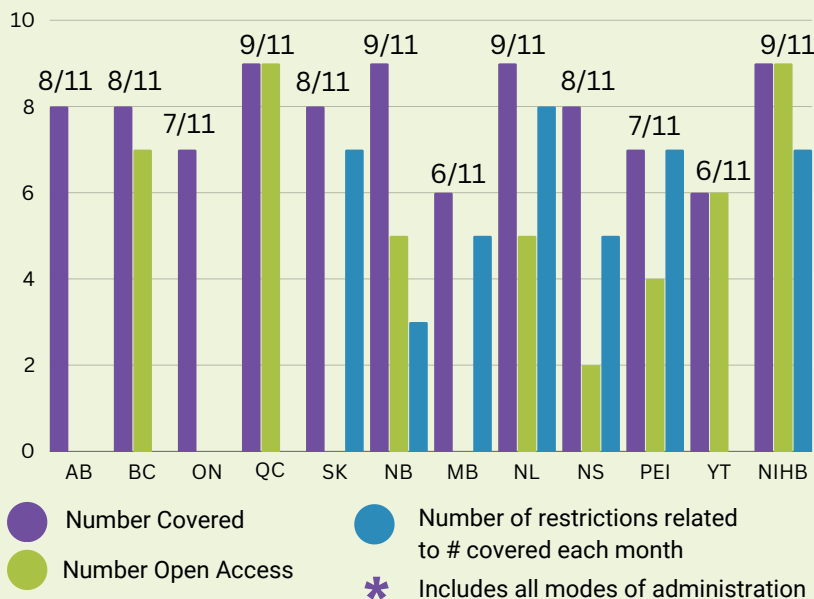

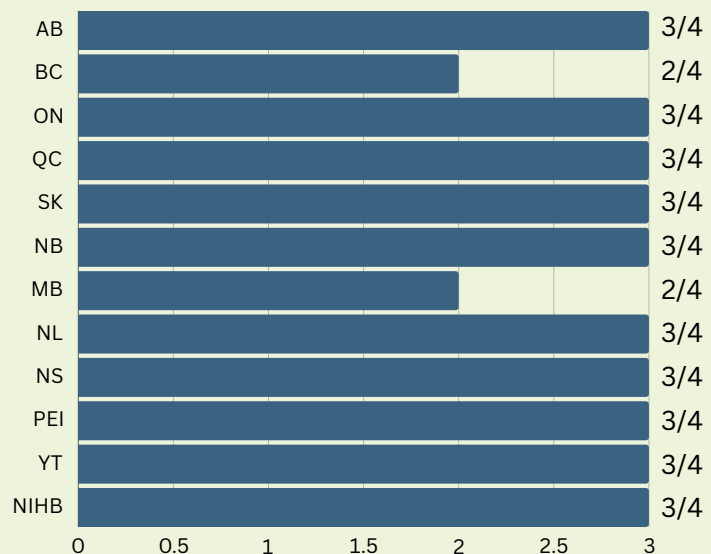
Provinces covering all triptans = 0

CGRP's available in Canada = 4

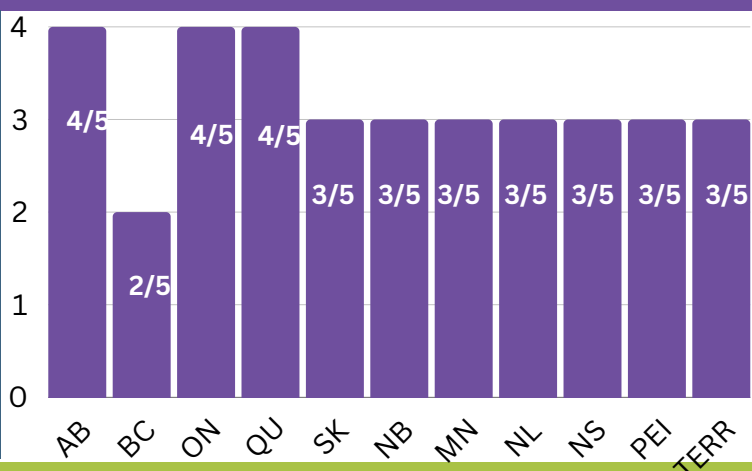
